

Battlefield LIVE Holiday Combat Academy

The Combat Academy involves the 'young recruits' taking part in a series of morning combat training exercises including planning a mission, patrolling, setting up a base camp, communication in the field, combat fitness and camouflage & concealment.

Then each afternoon they take part in different Battlefield Live exercises that will challenge what they have learnt in the mornings by putting it into real play scenarios and missions offering a diverse range of tactical and role playing situations. We select a range of missions to best suit the terrain in which we are operating and taking account of the age, size and interests of the group.

The Combat Academies offer fun and challenging activities for youngsters to really throw themselves into, all the while developing leadership, communication and organisation skills, and keeping them active and allowing them to make a whole range of new friends.

Please note the Combat Academy is designed as a complete programme, with each day's activity building on the children's previous day's experience. For this reason we are not able to accept bookings for a specific 'stand-alone' day.

What is the age range?

Battlefield Live Combat Academy is suitable for children aged 8 – 14 years.

Where is it?

What time does it run?

9.00am – 5.00pm each day (*you are able to drop off from 8:30am and pick up by 5:30pm depending on the time of year*)

How much does it cost?

5-day programme: £168.30 (£151.47 members)

Are there any discounts I can take advantage of?

Lifetime Membership is available for a one-off cost of £25.00 per child, which reduces the cost by 10%

We will also apply a 25% sibling discount to any booking where 2 or more siblings are attending the same programme. Discounts will be applied to the youngest sibling(s)

What should my child wear?

Comfortable clothing and suitable footwear is essential for roaming around in the woods as there is the possibility of them getting dirty and on rare occasions damaged. We recommend a change of clothes on days when activities include water sports in case of any mishaps.

We spend the whole time in the outdoors and would recommend ensuring your child has suitable clothing and accessories for the season (e.g. sun cream, waterproofs).

Does my child need to bring lunch?

Yes you will need to provide a packed lunch and plenty to drink.
